TASTING NOTES

This fresh young wine sports bright acidity up front, with notes of red berries, orange blossom and red grapefruit. A touch of sweetness rounds out the palate and softens the bubbles. With a bit of minerality and citrus zest on the finish, the 2023 Fizz is a refreshing, off-dry bubbly both dry and sweet wine drinkers will love.

PAIRING NOTES

This wine would pair well with a wide array of dishes, snacks and moments. We like to think of this as our every day wine during the holiday season, because every day calls for bubbles!

Preferred Dish: Chicken & Waffles

WINEMAKING NOTES

Being a nouveau wine, (*harvested & released in the same year*) this product was only in production for a few months. The grapes were whole cluster pressed and the juice fermented to about 1.5% residual sugar. This remaining sugar balances the acidity in the future wine.

We bottle the Fizz by hand in-house.

VINTAGE NOTES

The 2023 vintage overall was relatively hit or miss; a handful of varieties took it hard while others handled the weather quite well. We source the Pinot Noir for the Fizz from a grower we work with in Bridgeton, NJ about 45 minutes north of Hawk Haven. The Pinot Noir grapes came in very clean and sound lending to an excellent sparkling product!
